Day 1 (D) Madrid

Arrive MAD Airport

Our local guide will pick the group up and begin the panoramic sightseeing tour and discover the most important monuments of Madrid.

Dinner and accommodation in your hotel.

Day 2 (B, D) Madrid

Breakfast at hotel

Departure to **Medina del Campo** with a short stay, visit the Castle of the Mota, Main square of the Hispanidad.



Afterwards we continue our trip to **Tordesillas**, where we can visit the Royal Monastery of Sant Clara, Old palace built by Alfonso XI in the 14th century that was turned into a convent later by wish of Pedro I. It is considered to be one of the best examples of Mudejar art in Castile and Leon.



Our next stop is **Valladolid**, the city on the River Pisuerga. It preserves an interesting Renaissance group of buildings in its old neighborhood, churches and one of its most symbolic buildings, its Cathedral. The capital of Castilla-León enjoys an intense cultural life thanks to its situation as a university city.



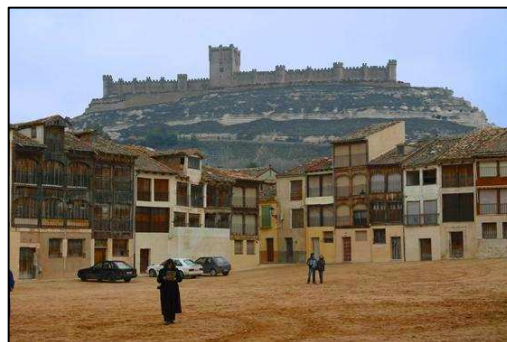
“Comida maridaje” and accommodation

Day 3(B, D) Valladolid

Breakfast at Hotel

Short visit of the historical center of Valladolid.

Begin of our route through *Castile wine regions*. **Peñafiel**. Here we visit the Museum of Wine, the best evidence of wine culture and wine art of the region, which is situated in an impressive castle. The Coloso Square and the Casa de Ribera are masterpieces of the popular architecture of the region.



We head for **Aranda del Duero**, a lovely town and capital of the region of Ribera del Duero.

After that we continue to **Burgos**.

A short visit of the old town of Burgos and its famous cathedral.

We visit the “**Peñalba Lopez**” wine cellar with wine sampling.



Dinner and accommodation.

Day 4 (B, D) Burgos

Breakfast at hotel

Short visit of the historical center of Burgos.

The afternoon we continue to Santo Domingo de la Calzada, where we can visit the Cathedral, The San Francisco Church and the Bernarda's Monastery.



We continue to **Laguardia** that has been declared a Historic-Artistic site. It preserves its medieval urban layout, being surrounded by a wall. Laguardia was founded in the 10th century after the construction of the castle, ordered by the Navarrese King Sancho Abarca. This place has a numerous wine cellars and an important wine tradition.

We visit one of the Wine Cellars called “**El Fabulista**” to get to know the traditional method of the wine production.



In the end of the day we arrive to **Logroño**.

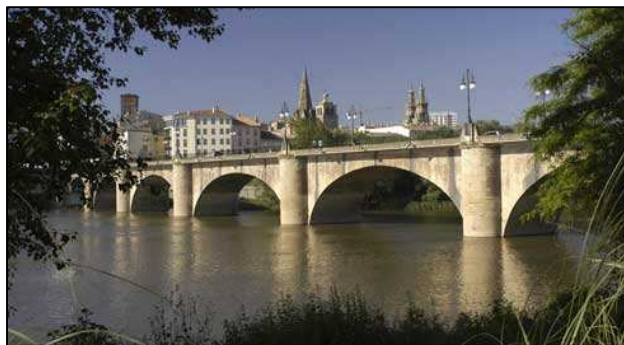
Dinner and accommodation.

Day 5 (B) Logroño

Breakfast at hotel

Today you start your journey from the famous wine region La Rioja. After a short visit of the capital of the region, **Logroño** with its cathedrals Santa Maria La Redonda, Santa María del Palacio and the Church of Bartolomé. **Ciudad del Vino**, located in Elciego (Alava), is a complex comprising the oldest winery of Rioja, **the winery of Marqués de Riscal (1858)** and a new building designed by the Canadian architect, **Frank O. Gehry**.

We recommend you to have a typical dinner in one of the most famous “tapas” bar streets. Enjoy nightlife with different wine sorts.

Day 6 (B, D) Logroño

Breakfast at hotel

Today we start our journey through **Calahorra**, **Alfaro**, and **Tudela** another lovely town of Navarra founded by Muslims. Its Cathedral, the Church of Santa Magdalena and the square “Plaza de los Fueros” are one of the most interesting monuments.



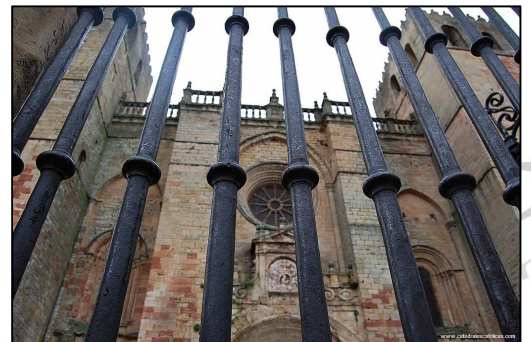
In the end of the day we travel to **Zaragoza**.

Day 7 (B, D) Zaragoza

Breakfast at hotel

We travel to Guadalajara through **Calatayud**. We arrive to **Sigüenza** a beautiful city in the northern region of the province of Guadalajara, whose lofty architectural heritage was declared a Historic-Artistic Site in 1965, we visit the the castle, the cathedral, and the main square.



Continue to **Madrid**.
